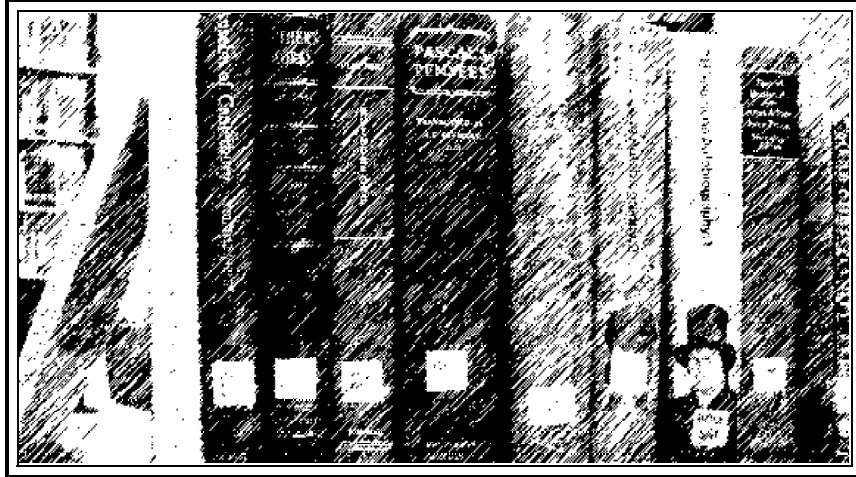


Get to Know the Classics
